WEX (Yawns) What a busy day it's been! I'm so tired, I can't wait
to get some sleep.

STELLA He was so tired, he started to snore.
But before too long there was a knock at the door.

Song 1 Knock! Knock!

RAFFY This is all too much! Don't people know what time it is?
I'm off back to bed!

EVELYN We must go and find the shepherds and tell them the
joyous news.

VICTORIA They will have to follow the star if they want to get to
Bethlehem.

Song 2 Tonight!

(As angels exit, guests begin to socialise, filling the main stage)

RUBY Our innkeeper was hoping that he'd get a rest
He hadn't expected this number of guests.

VICTOR Laughing, chatting, stamping feet!
Stopped our innkeeper from getting to sleep.

Song 3. Innkeeper's Song

WEX *(To guests)* Please be reasonable. It's very late. Now - go
to your rooms.

OPHELIA The innkeeper was tired and sad,
On the busiest night he'd ever had.

Song 4 Knock! Knock! (Mary and Joseph)

As innkeeper turns to walk away

JOSIAH Please sir, can't you help us? We've come so far. We don't
mind where we sleep! *(Innkeeper stops, turns round and
reconsiders)*

WEX Well, I suppose I could squeeze you into the stable.

HOWIE The stable was crowded and smelly as well,
But Mary and Joseph decided to dwell.

ARCHIE It smells of poo!

*Main stage now becomes a stable scene, with appropriate props and
Animals*

Song 6. It's a baby

LEO I We were in the fields and saw a shining star.

ZOE We followed the star and we have come to celebrate the
new baby boy.

WEX *(Announces)* This calls for a celebration. Drinks are on the
house! Come on, let's prepare a feast. *(Exits with some of
the guests)*

RAFFY They'll be plenty for everyone! Come and celebrate.

FARON What a great day!

EVERYONE Hallelujah! Hooray!

YEAR 1 PERFORMANCE OF LITTLE SHEPHERD BOY

There's a knock at the stable door

JOSIAH *(Gets up to answer the door)* I wonder who that could be?

JONAH Three wise men appeared, who had come from afar,
They had followed a glittery shining star.

Song 7. Wisemen

JEM I bring gold for the newborn king.

LAMIN I bring myrrh for the new baby.

XAVI I bring frankincense for the King of Kings.

As wise men sit with Mary, there's another knock at the door.

WEX *(As he comes in carrying drinks) I'll get it! (Opens door)*

Song 8. Worship Song

LEO M What remarkable things we've seen this night!
A miracle birth! What a wonderful sight!

Song 9. Hallelujah

JONAH As innkeeper, shepherds, and wise men now sing

AHMED Let's join with the angels to worship the King.

Song 10. I Wish it Could be Xmas Everyday
