Quality of Education (curriculum intent, implementation and impact)

- Support teachers to further improve the quality of teaching in Religious Education.

- Develop curriculum pathways for children with a range of additional needs.
- Complete the work on curriculum overviews in all areas of our curriculum.

- Relaunch the STEAM room, enhancing the science offer in our school.

Personal Development and Wellbeing

• Develop the skills of SEND pupils and their families by using the goal, plan, do, review approach, with Occupational Therapists leading training for all staff.

Behaviour and Attitudes

- Develop the skills of all staff, helping them to de escalate behaviour incidents and training them to lead restorative approached to resolution.
- Involve the Rights Respecting School Council in decision making via regular meetings.
- Develop "Quiet Club" options for children during lunch play.

Leadership and Management (including Governance)

- Link the appraisal process for teachers and TAs ensuring training and development impacts on provision for children and staff development.
- Refine the use of Team Meetings to maximise their impact for all team members.
